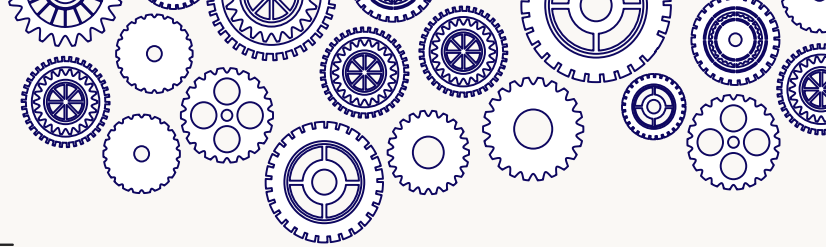

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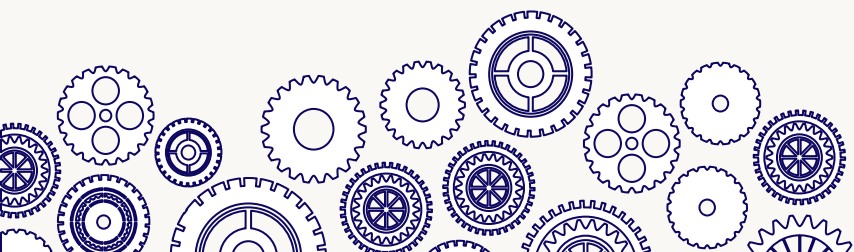

Happy Feast of St Ignatius

Dear Officials, Staff (teaching and non-teaching, administrative, technical, supportive), Alumni, Students, Parents, and Well-Wishers of Loyola,

Greetings. Every year when we celebrate the feast of St Ignatius, Founder of the Jesuit Order (popularly known as the Jesuits), we find him inspiring us more and more (magis). He was God-conscious and was aware that we come from God and we would return to God, which is also the reflection and the teaching of the great theologian Thomas Aquinas: *exitus et reditus* - The coming forth and turning back as the double law of God's creation.

St Ignatius lived out this principle: He was seeking everything in God and found everything in God. In The Spiritual Exercises, he mentions, right at the beginning, that the creation is for us and we need to use them responsibly (Principle and Foundation - SpEx 23); and towards the end of the book, he is thrilled to see God working for each one of us in creation (Contemplation to attain Love - SpEx 236).

The 'cannonball experiences' he had were the turning points in his life. When his right knee was shattered by a cannonball while defending the Pamplona fort (20 May 1421), he turned from the world to God; sitting at the bank of the river Cardoner, he was transformed and he saw everything anew in God - This was a spiritual cannonball experience. And later, on his way to Rome at La Storta, he was assured of God being propitious to him in Rome (when he would meet the Pope) - This was an administrative cannonball experience, for this experience was the igniting moment for St Ignatius to found the Company of Jesus.

We too might have had many a cannonball experience that would have befallen us (though they might be hopeless in the beginning), God would transform them as His blessings. We believe that God can write straight even on crooked lines. Let us find God in the shocking Covid pandemic, in the frustrating lockdown, and in the threatening third wave. These may be storms in the tea cup, for God could calm down hurricanes and cyclones in our lives and bring in peace of mind and serenity of heart.

St Ignatius stands out as an example and our model. As we celebrate his feast, let us put on his hope and vision to seek God in everything and to find everything/everyone in God. Wish you all the happy feast of St Ignatius. The Jesuits at Loyola (Chennai) assure you of our prayers and continued walking with you in your lives and mission.
